

# ABOUT

## **Mission**

To spread awareness in the society and encourage individuals to live a dignified life.

## **Vision**

To create a community free of oppression and exploitation.

Manobal A New Beginning Foundation is a dedicated anti-human trafficking organization that works to protect, rescue, rehabilitate, and empower individuals—especially girls and women—who have been trapped in sexual exploitation. Our approach is holistic, survivor-centered, and rooted in dignity, compassion, and human rights.

Human trafficking is not just a crime; it is a violation of humanity. Many victims are tricked through false job offers, emotional manipulation, or financial desperation. Once trapped, they face violence, abuse, and psychological trauma. At Manobal, we believe that no one deserves to be treated as a commodity. Every person has the right to live with freedom, safety, and hope.

We work across every stage of intervention:

1. **Identification and Interception** Our teams observe high-risk communities and vulnerable populations to prevent trafficking before it occurs.
2. **Rescue in Collaboration with Law Enforcement** We work alongside police and Anti-Human Trafficking Units to coordinate safe rescue operations and provide post-rescue legal and emotional support.
3. **Rehabilitation and Psychosocial Support** Survivors receive counseling, healthcare, legal aid, and safe shelter to begin the healing process.
4. **Skill Development and Empowerment** We provide education and training to help survivors rebuild their confidence and become economically independent.
5. **Awareness and Prevention** Through community awareness and the Abhas Project, we educate youth, parents, and communities to recognize and prevent trafficking risks.
6. **Repatriation and Restoration** We ensure survivors are safely reintegrated into society or reunited with families through coordinated agency support.


Our philosophy is rooted in dignity and empowerment — survivors are not victims; they are resilient individuals reclaiming their lives with strength and hope.






