

Manobal is involved in anti-human trafficking efforts through interception, reporting, rescue, rehabilitation, repatriation, and restoration. We provide 24×7 help to people in need of liberation from trafficking. We conduct intelligence-based operations and rescue sex trafficking victims with the help of the police.

Manobal strives to support survivors of sex-trafficking in every phase of their journey to freedom; through counselling, legal help, and mentorship. We 'walk' with the victim all the way to her restoration and reintegration back into the society.


We also strive to empower survivors to overcome their traumatic past and be the leading voice in shaping policy and public awareness.

Manobal is founded by Nirmala Walter, a social worker who has been working relentlessly to rescue girls and women from brothels and sex rackets in India, for over 15 years. 

AWARENESS

Awareness is the foundation of prevention. Manobal begins its anti-trafficking work by building public understanding of how trafficking occurs, who is most vulnerable, and how it can be prevented. When communities are informed, they are better equipped to recognize warning signs, challenge harmful practices, and take timely action.

Public awareness is one of the most cost-effective and far-reaching strategies in the fight against human trafficking. It multiplies impact by engaging families, youth, community leaders, and institutions as active protectors. By strengthening knowledge and vigilance at the grassroots level, Manobal addresses trafficking before exploitation begins—making awareness the first and most essential step toward prevention.

SOCIAL WELLBEING



Manobal is rooted in the belief that love and compassion can truly change lives. Rather than approaching vulnerable individuals with judgment or force, we choose empathy, respect, and genuine human connection. During festivals and celebrations, when isolation is often felt most deeply, our teams reach out to sex workers to build trust and meaningful relationships.

By consistently showing care and concern, Manobal creates bridges that open pathways to safety, support, and freedom. These compassionate engagements allow us to identify those seeking help, offer alternatives to exploitation, and walk alongside them toward rescue, rehabilitation, and restored dignity.



RESCUE AND REPATRIATION

This year marked a significant milestone for Manobal with our first international rescue—the successful intervention and restoration of a Ugandan woman named Mona. With Manobal’s support, Mona was able to step out of the darkness of prostitution and courageously lodge a formal complaint with the police. Following her rescue, she was safely repatriated to her home country, where Rahab Uganda, Manobal’s trusted partner organization, walked alongside her in the journey of healing and reintegration. Today, Mona runs a small soft drink shop, independently supporting herself and her children, and living with dignity as part of mainstream society.

In addition to this landmark rescue, Manobal carried out two more rescue operations within India—one in Pune, Maharashtra, and another at Nizamuddin Railway Station. Each intervention reflects our continued commitment to identifying victims, responding swiftly, and ensuring survivors are connected to protection, justice, and long-term restoration. Together, these rescues stand as powerful testimonies of hope, courage, and transformed lives.



TRAINING AND WORKSHOPS



Manobal places strong emphasis on sensitizing government officials and organizations working in the anti-human trafficking ecosystem. Through structured training and awareness sessions, we equip frontline stakeholders with the knowledge and skills needed to identify, prevent, and respond effectively to trafficking situations.

Our sensitization programs focus on understanding the multiple dimensions of human trafficking, recognizing indicators through body language and behavioral cues, and addressing the mental health needs of survivors with sensitivity and care. By strengthening the capacity of officials and partner organizations, Manobal helps create a coordinated, informed, and compassionate response system that protects victims and promotes justice.
